Transformation Drawing

Transformation definition: a thorough or dramatic change in form or appearance.

Supplies: Pencil, paper, eraser. You may use other supplies if you'd like to.

Steps.

- 1. Read the list of expectations before you begin.
- 2. Think of two physical things (toys, machines, animals, food, etc.) you would like to draw.
- 3. Draw one of those things on the left side of your paper and draw the other thing on the right side of your paper.
- 4. In between those drawings, make at least two more drawings that show the stages of the first thing transforming into the second thing. See example below.

Expectations:

- □ You will have a minimum of 4 drawings on your page.
- □ You will take time to draw, shade, and add detail.

Drawing tip:

When I'm drawing, I find it helpful to look at the subject I want to draw, whether it's in a photograph or right in front of me. If I were drawing a baseball glove, I would find it helpful to look at a real baseball glove so that I could see all the details and observe the shadows.
