

Transformation Drawing

Transformation definition: a thorough or dramatic change in form or appearance.

Supplies: Pencil, paper, eraser. You may use other supplies if you'd like to.

Steps.

1. Read the list of expectations before you begin.
2. Think of two physical things (toys, machines, animals, food, etc.) you would like to draw.
3. Draw one of those things on the left side of your paper and draw the other thing on the right side of your paper.
4. In between those drawings, make at least two more drawings that show the stages of the first thing transforming into the second thing. See example below.

Expectations:

- You will have a minimum of 4 drawings on your page.
- You will take time to draw, shade, and add detail.

Drawing tip:

When I'm drawing, I find it helpful to look at the subject I want to draw, whether it's in a photograph or right in front of me. If I were drawing a baseball glove, I would find it helpful to look at a real baseball glove so that I could see all the details and observe the shadows.
